ERS of Texas undergoes Sunset Review

The Texas Sunset Advisory Commission is currently studying the mission and performance of the Employees Retirement System of Texas to determine if the state employee retirement program can be improved. The review is required under the Texas Sunset Act but, unlike other state agencies, the ERS is not subject to abolishment under the Act.

The first phase of the ERS Sunset Review began with a self-evaluation report submitted by the ERS, and will conclude with a systemic evaluation conducted by Sunset staff and a staff report scheduled for delivery in April. About a month after this report is made, the Sunset Commission will hear public testimony and subsequently adopt recommendations for the legislature to consider when it convenes in January 2017.
