BOARD DIRECTIVE

SUBJECT: PAROLE PANELS

PURPOSE: To establish parole panels for matters of release on parole, release to mandatory supervision, and revocation of parole or mandatory supervision.

AUTHORITY: Texas Government Code Sections 508.035(d) and 508.045

DISCUSSION: The statute requires the Presiding Officer of the Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles (Board) to designate the composition of each panel and designate the panels composed of at least one (1) Board Member and any combination of Board Members and Parole Commissioners.

This directive designates parole panels for all parole decisions except those decisions requiring all members of the Board to vote for the release of an offender pursuant to Section 508.046, Government Code.

However, regardless of the parole panels designated in this directive, the Presiding Officer authorizes any combination of Board Members or Parole Commissioners to vote any offender's case as a parole panel regardless of the Board office assignment, and regardless of where the offender is housed or being supervised.

Additionally, the Presiding Officer authorizes Board Members to substitute on any panel and vote in the place of any Board Member or Parole Commissioner, with one exception: no one can replace the Presiding Officer in voting on a MRIS panel. The Board Members are Marsha Moberley (Presiding Officer), Elodia Brito, Clint Gunnels, Brian Long, Linda Molina, Ed Robertson, and Sandra Fletcher.

DIRECTIVE: Effective August 1, 2026, the following parole panels replace all previously designated ones:

Panel No. 1, or any combination thereof, shall serve as the Special Review and Motions to Reopen Hearing panel. This panel will consider and decide requests for action upon review of additional information and releasee's motion to reopen hearing or reinstate supervision pursuant to Board rules 145.1, 145.17, and 146.11:

Panel No. 1 Brito, Marton, Phillips

Panel Nos. 2 - 3, or any combination thereof, shall serve as the Texas Juvenile Justice Department (TJJD) panels. These panels will determine the conditions of parole for a person who is transferred to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) under Section 54.11, Texas Juvenile Justice Code, pursuant to Section 508.156, Government Code, and BPP-DIR.145.350:

Panel No. 2 Robertson, Hardges, Tejada

Panel No. 3 Hardges, Tejada, Robertson

Panel Nos. 4 - 7, or any combination thereof, shall serve as the Medically Recommended Intensive Supervision (MRIS) panels. These panels will determine eligibility for MRIS and make recommendations for release to MRIS pursuant to Section 508.146, Government Code:

Panel No. 5 Moberley, Hardges, Tejada

Panel No. 6 Moberley, Farley, Robertson

Panel No. 7 Robertson, Hardges, Moberley

Panel Nos. 8 - 10, or any combination thereof, shall serve as the Super Intensive Supervision Program (SISP) panels. These panels will consider and decide requests pursuant to BPP-POL. 145.260:

Panel No. 10 Hardges, Tejada, Robertson

Panel Nos. 11 - 14, or any combination thereof, shall serve as the Sex Offender Condition Hearing (SOCH) panels. These panels will consider and decide requests pursuant to BPP-DIR. 148.300:

Panel No. 13 Long, Kiel, Butler

Panel No. 14 Butler, Adams, Moberley

Panel Nos. 15 - 17, or any combination thereof, shall serve as the Early Release on Parole (ERP) panels. These panels will consider and decide requests pursuant to BPP-POL. 145.209:
