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BOARD POLICY REPEAL

BOARD POLICY REPEAL BPP-POL. 145.264 SPECIAL CONDITION "Z"

(NOT TO RESIDE IN OR ENTER A SPECIFIED COUNTY)

WHEREAS the Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles (Board) readopted Board Policy BPP-POL.145.264 Special Condition "Z" (Not to Reside in Or Enter a Specified County), hereby incorporated by reference, on January 18, 2024 in an Open Meeting held pursuant to Government Code Section 508.047; and

WHEREAS the Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles has determined that while Government Code Section 508.221 authorizes a parole panel to impose any condition a court may impose on a defendant placed on community supervision under Chapter 42A, Code of Criminal Procedure, Government Code Section 508.181 Residence During Release does not authorize a parole panel to prohibit an offender from entering a specified county; and

THEREFORE, the Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles does hereby repeal Board Policy BPP-POL. 145.264 Special Condition "Z" (Not to Reside in Or Enter a Specified County).

NOW THEREFORE, Special Condition "Z" may not be imposed upon offenders on or after October 01, 2024, and

NOW THEREFORE, Special Condition "Z" shall remain in effect if the condition was imposed prior to October 1, 2024.
