All Adult visitors will be asked to provide identification prior to entering the visitation area. Visitor Identification for visitors 18 years of age and older, is a pictured and signed identification (ID) of one (1) of the following: (1) valid state drivers' license; (2) valid state Department of Public Safety (DPS) ID card; (3) valid Armed Forces ID card; (4) passport; or (5) ID card issued by the United States Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Citizenship & Immigration Services (USCIS) (i.e., Visa Border Crossing ID Card [USA B1/B2 Visa BCC]). Children 17 years of age and younger may be required to provide an ID (e.g., birth certificate, DPS ID or student ID) if the child's age is questionable due to physical maturity of the child. A valid student ID shall be used only for children 17 years old and younger. Identification is required for hardship visitors. You must have the original form of identification with you upon check-in.
