

TREATMENT ALTERNATIVE TO INCARCERATION PROGRAM (TAIP)

ROLE OF TAIP

- A probation sentencing diversion for the judiciary for offenders with substance abuse problems
- Current programs in 25 Community Supervision and Corrections Departments (CSCDs) providing services to 114 Texas counties
- The TAIP programs provide:
 - Substance abuse screening, assessment/evaluation,
 - In-house services or referrals for substance abuse treatment, including:
 - Detoxification treatment
 - Intensive residential treatment
 - Residential treatment
 - Outpatient substance abuse counseling
